
LOVE YOUR PARKS & COMMUNITY

Safety Instructions and Cleanup Guidelines

- Tie off trash bags and dispose of them in a trash can or dumpster. Please also consider taking the trash home with you and putting it out for your regular weekly collection.
- Post a photo of your filled trash bag(s) or bucket on social media.

- Don't forget to include the name of the park or neighborhood street.



STAY SAFE WHILE PARTICIPATING IN A CLEAN-UP
