

Measure S


- Measure S Passed 69%

Current District Maps


- 4 Community Meetings

 - Equal Representation (<10% Variance)
 - Voting age residents




- I. Equal Population*

Laws

Federal Voter's Rights Act (VRA)

- I. Equal Population (<10% deviation)
- 2. Federal Voting Rights Act
- 3. No Racial Gerrymandering

FAIR MAPS Act

Hearings

- Minimum 4 Public Hearings
- 1 I Pre-Draft Map
- 2 Post-Draft Map
- +1 Either Pre- or Post-Map

- Council must hold meetings
- Consultant/staff can host 1 pre-draft map hearing
- Fixed Start Times
- One After 6 p.m. or Weekend
- Live Interpretation (requested w/in 72 hours)
- ADA Accessible

- Place for Public Comments

- Notices (5-Day) and Agendas
- Recordings / Summaries w/in

FAIR MAPS Act

Public Participation and Engagement (Good Faith Effort)

Broadly distribute to community groups and media

Draft Maps

- 21-Day Waiting Period after Census
- Final Draft Map posted 7-days before adoption

Redistricting Principles

Some Redistricting Principles

- Communities of Interest (groups
 - w/ similarities other than race)
- Keep districts compact

- Contiguous
- Defined by visible boundaries
 - (Man-made or natural)
