BACKGROUND:

Overview

This agenda report outlines the fourth of four required Redistricting Hearings to gather public input about El Cajon's City Council district election boundaries. This report provides an overview of the redistricting process, redistricting criteria, and draft maps received along with demographic summaries for each map.

Background

In 2016, City residents passed Measure S, transitioning the City from an at-large election system to a district-based election process. This means that the City must reevaluate its voting districts every ten years following the release of the decennial Census data to ensure that the districts remain balanced.

On September 27, 2021, the State of California released the 2020 U.S. Census data. National Demographics Corporation ("NDC"), the City's demographer, analyzed this data against the City's current District Map and found that the districts remain balanced. The difference between the lowest and highest populous districts is 5.35%, which is below the 10% threshold for a map to be considered "presumptively constitutional" or balanced under the Federal Voters Act Equal Population requirement. For this reason, the current District Election Map has been advanced by the City Council to be considered as part of today's map selection process.

Redistricting Process

The Federal Voting Rights Act and California's AB 849, known as the Fair and Inclusive Redistricting for Municipal and Political Subdivisions Act ("FAIR MAPS Act" or "Act"), define the redistricting process. The FAIR MAPS Act requires cities to host four redistricting hearings, use prioritized redistricting criteria, notify the public about upcoming hearings, create a dedicated webpage, translate materials for the website, and provide for live interpretation during public hearings when requested in advance.

The City has not only met the FAIR MAPS Act requirements but has often exceeded the Act's specifications. For instance, the Act specifies that at least one of the Redistricting Hearings be held on a Saturday *or* after 6 p.m. on a weekday. On June 22, 2021, the City Council approved a schedule of Redistricting Hearings, choosing to hold every hearing after-hours or on the weekend in an effort to encourage broad community participation. The hearings were also located in each of the City's four council districts to increase access to the hearings.

The FAIR MAPS Act also requires Cities to translate specific materials into other languages. The California Secretary of State determines the language requirements when 3% or more of a City's population speaks a specific language. In El Cajon, those languages are English, Arabic, Spanish, and Somali. The City expanded the list of language translations provided to also include Dari and Pashto, the two official languages spoken in Afghanistan. In addition, the City has translated additional materials beyond what is required including translating a how-to video for online mapping, presentations, flyers, and banners.

Redistricting Criteria:

During today's Redistricting Hearing, the City Council will receive testimony from the public about the draft maps. Following the Hearing, the City Council will have the opportunity to discuss and select a map, which will be formalized at its City Council meeting on February 8, 2022, at 7 p.m., through the adoption of an ordinance.

The FAIR MAPS Act specifies that the following prioritized criteria must be met in order to adopt an election district boundary map:

- 1. complies with the Voting Rights Act and its Equal Population requirement,
- 2. is geographically contiguous,
- 3. is made up of undivided "neighborhoods of interest,"
- 4. has easily identifiable boundaries, and
- 5. is compact.

The FAIR MAPS Act also prohibits discrimination against a political party and the Federal Voting Rights Act prohibits "gerrymandering" based on race.

In addition, there are several traditional districting principles that can be considered. These include minimizing voter shifts to different election years, respecting voters' choices, and future population growth.


Draft Maps

The City received thirteen draft maps for consideration. Each map includes a demographic breakdown by district. Attached to this report is each map (in the order received by the City) as well as demographic data. If the City Council selects a map today, staff plans to present the City Council with an ordinance to formally adopt the map during its City Council meeting at 7 p.m. on February 8, 2022. The City must have an approved map by April 17, 2022, to comply with California election laws.
