Access Site

Serves as a starting point for housing resources

General Population: 1st and 3rd Thursday: 12:30pm-4pm

Homeless Street Outreach

Meets and engages individuals experiencing homelessness throughout East County.

- City of Lemon Grove
- HHAP (East County)

The outreach team connects individuals with resources and provides basic needs such as food and hygiene.

Home Start is part of Homeless Outreach Team (HOT) with the El Cajon Police Department, San Diego Sheriff Department HART, and Santee Sheriff Department HOPE Team.

Host Homes

Temporary housing placements in community members' homes for individuals experiencing homelessness between the ages of 14-24 years old. Availability is dependent on the host. Hosts receive a small stipend. Youth are provided intensive case management and are required to be productive and working towards self-sufficiency.

Youth System Navigation

Outreach and in-reach services to youth 18-24 years old. Youth Systems Navigators (YSN) are focused on providing diversion, prevention, and identifying other resources to obtain stability and self-sufficiency.

Housing Navigation

Housing services and navigation are provided in partnership with La Mesa's HOME (Homeless Outreach Mobile Engagement).

Housing Our Youth (HOY)

Specialized assistance to Transitional Aged Youth (TAY) throughout San Diego County who are at-risk or experiencing homelessness. HOY services include housing, peer support, care coordination, service navigation, transportation, job preparation, subsidized employment, education assistance, tenant support, and other wrap-around services as needed to help youth remain stably housed and prepared for self-sufficiency. We also support Bridge Housing opportunities.
