

**NOTICE TO VOTERS OF DATE AFTER WHICH NO ARGUMENTS  
FOR OR AGAINST CITY MEASURES MAY BE SUBMITTED TO  
THE CITY CLERK**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of El Cajon on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following measure:

<b>EL CAJON CRITICAL SERVICES MEASURE</b>	Yes
<p>To prevent substantial cuts to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The number of firefighters/paramedics;</li> <li>• The number of police officers (including patrol, crime prevention, and homeless enforcement);</li> <li>• Street maintenance (for example, pothole repair and repaving); and</li> <li>• Other essential City services;</li> </ul> <p>shall the City continue the ½ cent sales tax approved by the voters in 2008, for additional 20 years, with oversight from a Citizens' Committee?</p>	No

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the Legislative Body of the City, or any member or members thereof authorized by the body, or an individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations, may file a written argument, not to exceed 300 words in length, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name of the signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, for or against the City Measures.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, based on the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and voter information guide for the election, the City Clerk has fixed **Thursday, August 15, 2024**, during normal office hours as posted, as the date after which no arguments for or against the City measure may be submitted to the City clerk for printing and distribution to the voters as provided in Article 4. Arguments shall be submitted to the City Clerk, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument at the Office of the City Clerk, 200 Civic Center Way, El Cajon, California. Arguments may be changed or withdrawn until and including the date affixed by the City Clerk.

NOTICE IF FURTHER GIVEN that the City Council has determined that rebuttal arguments, not to exceed 250 words in length, as submitted by the authors of opposing direct arguments, may be filed with the City Clerk not later than Tuesday, August 20, 2024, during normal office hours as posted, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument.

NOTICE IF FURTHER GIVEN that any ordinance, measure, impartial analysis, or direct argument filed under the authority of the elections code will be available for public examination in the City Clerk's Office for not less than 10 calendar days from the respective deadlines for the filing of those materials. Any rebuttal argument filed under the authority of the elections code will be available for public examination in the City Clerk's office for not less than 10 calendar days from the deadline for filing rebuttal arguments.
